- STEP 1: VERIFY** Verify you are ready for a gas service line by: Reviewing, Completing & Signing **Yard Line Checklist and Application Form**

- STEP 3: CONFIRM** AmeriGas will contact you within 24hrs to confirm the receipt of your application. If you do not receive a call please contact us to verify your application arrived.

YARD LINE CHECKLIST FORM

**Are you ready to order your AmeriGas LP gas yard line?
We need these things before we can proceed with installation:**

- The LP gas stub-out coming from the house must be five (5) feet from any other source of ignition. (Please call the office to request a Guide to Meter Location)
- The LP gas yard line should be ordered when the house is almost completely built out, but before the installation of landscaping or driveways.
- There should be no scaffolding or other obstructions on the lot to allow room for large equipment.

Yard Line Costs

AmeriGas uses OQ qualified contractors to install the LP gas service lines for each service address (or additional pool/outdoor appliance). These service lines are billed to the homebuilder according to the total cost of installation including: subcontractor time & materials and any necessary AmeriGas time & materials.

**Note: If requested, AmeriGas will provide an estimate to the homebuilder prior to installation.*

Acknowledgement

By signing below, I am verifying that all of these checklist items are complete or I have contacted AmeriGas otherwise and have made alternative arrangements. I am also acknowledging that, as the current "home owner", I am responsible for any damage incurred to the installed LP gas service line by future subcontractors while the service address is in my name. The costs involved with "Line Hits" are usually the loss of product, emergency response time & materials and any repair costs to the damaged line.

***Note: To avoid civil penalties and line damage, all excavators/subcontractors are required to use the Texas One-Call system by dialing "811" to request a line locate before digging. This is required by law.**
